



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS RE: THE SUMMIT PARK HOA

Q. What's in it for me?

A. The Summit Park HOA board of directors are your recognized voice to the county for issues and concerns.

Q. Are the directors paid to be on the board?

A. No, they are committed volunteers with the same interest as you, to do what's best for our community.

Q. Where does the money go we pay for dues?

A. It goes directly into our community and covers expenses such as our lease to the State for the entrance sign location, spring dumpster rentals, mailings, web page design, fire prevention and education programs.

Q. Why do we need CCR's any way?

A. They help interpret the county developmental code and address the unique challenges we face here in SP.

Q. Why should I get involved with the HOA.

A. Everyone has an interest in seeing SP thrive economically and aesthetically while maintaining a safe place to raise our children. There is such a great talent of people with in our community. Combining that variety of expertise with a commitment to serve will help assure those aspects.

Q. Will the CC&R's restrict us on how we live or build our home?
