 - We finished the year with the highest paid dues, which is great, but we still have a long way to go
 - Update from Architectural Board Lauren
 - We have some new members joining
 - Lauren has reached out to the county. Need to reach out the engineers and real estate companies.
 - Mark to talk to board of relators; cc Lauren
 - Revive the welcome packet. The packet will include:

 - County has agreed to improve the bus stop on Parkview and Lower Evergreen
 - Contact Paul if you want to input on how it's changed
 - Request from Jess to add crosswalk and/or bus stop sign on Woodland
 - County will strip the roads differently next year
 - Egress between SP and Timberline currently debris in front of the emergency gate
 - Possible to make that gate a breakaway?

 - Always try to get there the next day please bring in to allow the plows to go through

- Who do we call if they miss a street? Call Republic Services
- Recycling:
 - Soft grocery plastic bags please do not put in recycling; collect and then either take back to Smiths or Recycle Utah
 - Quick rinse and very quick dry, don't put the lids back on
 - When in doubt, throw it out
- Plow driving -
 - If there are questions or feedback, reach out to Public Works or relay through Rachel
 - County now has a profile on NextDoor so also making announcements there
 - Sheriff is also on board with NextDoor
 - Making trips to landfills:
 - Bring pesticides, toxic waste, oil, aerosol cans with paint, oil spray cans
 - If you're doing a big project/remodeling, go directly to Hennifer
- There was another fire in Summit Park
 - Off of Lower Evergreen around Christmas
 - Street parking was an issue was hard for fire trucks to navigate our roads
 - Cause: Electrical, gas meter was covered by the snow, which did not help
 - The tenant did not know where to shut off was

 - Talking to the noise engineer J-breaks
 - May need petition from residents
 - Mufflers what we want is the state enforcing a law
 - Eric to continue his conversations and circle back with the HOA to let us know if/how the HOA could support

 - Resident found a shanty of sorts off of St. Moritz by the water tower think it's private land
 - HOA will reach out to the sheriff about this and another property
