    - Firewise Basin Rec is engaging in another fire mitigation project right now. Fully funded through federal grants, setting up a fire break
    - Installed a breakaway gate
    - Suggestion: get a sign for emergency access/exit routes
    - Creek trail trail maintenance please leave the slash piles, they are there to restore the routes
    - $\circ$   $\,$  Management plan on Toll Canyon is two years old and it's updated every ~5 years  $\,$
    - Most of Toll Canyon is only hiking only, Jeep roads up to the Summit
      - Working on designing and implementing stage for the trails that will connect WOS and Toll Canyon - will be multi-access
      - Hope is to reduce traffic and parking up on Summit Park
    - Discovery Development Project behind the Wileman School
      - Basin gets a 1 acre parcel for a trailhead and then 40 acres of open space planning to connect that to Summit Park
      - Trailhead will have parking, bathroom (behind Wileman school)
      - Hope to build more trails in that area as well after hiking only and multi use trails
- Traffic updates (Fran and Brandon) 15 minutes
  - Brandon Brady
    - Three traffic studies over the last year
    - Traffic calming committee
      - Two of the three areas don't fall within the parameters to qualify for the program
      - Put up curve signs and 25 mph signs and "slow children" signs + sharrows
      - Improved Parkview over the last 6 years trying to widen to 24 feet, giving peds more room to walk but also increased speeding
      - Putting up own speed humps please do not, the county confiscates them; they can become dangerous because they are only loose
      - Noise of trucks going down the streets for construction can we put any restrictions? Can't restrict as long as they are legal loads on public roads
        - There is a noise ordinance
        - If we want signage, HOA can ask about that
      - Signs for 1-80 HOA to follow up on that
      - Safer bus stops for kids
        - 2 on Parkview under review to see how they can make it safer
