- New board member
  - Chris Quinones was voted in unanimously
- FireWise Sites of Excellence
  - Would like to mail out announcement and call to action to sign up
    - Chris to look at the cost of mailings
  - Megan to share video that Mike sent out on the website and blog
- Dumpster Days
  - Need more communication and reminders to sign up
    - Specify what the job is
  - Signage in the community -
    - Mike and Fran to work on signage
  - FireWise event
    - Mike will talk to On Top, plan event and secure food
- Chipping
  - NFPA giving us \$1,000 for chipping
  - Will do earlier this year probably June
- FireWise Grants
  - \$10K
  - Megan to get paperwork organized
- Wildlife
  - Cougar sighting in the neighborhood keep pets safe
- Watershed Grant
  - Jess will let us know when she hears more answer should be coming any day now

### Community Meeting - wildfire focus:

- Background:
  - Mike is the lead of safety and fire in the neighborhood, has been living here for more than 20 years
  - We have overlapping properties in Summit Park, which is a fire danger
  - Summit Park is involved in various state and national programs
  - Travis Wright and Alex with DNR working with them through the state

- Sites of Excellence Program two year commitment, get free assessment and then track your time and expenses towards creating defensible space
  - Room for ~70-80 participants
  - Hope to have a few FireWise project days where we can all team up and help residents clear brush and show best practices
  - $\circ$   $\;$  Site visit by NFPA will happen sometime during the summer  $\;$
  - Need people to keep track of times (time spent clearing brush, researching information, etc.), expenses (hiring to get a tree removed, equipment costs and rental fees, etc.) - please document because it goes towards the in-kind donation and that means we get more money back in our community
    - Currently the rate at which they calculate that is \$25/hour
  - The HOA will send out a form quarterly to track the progress
  - HOA will send out a form to sign up for your personalized assessment
- Other HOA programs
  - Tree Bounty program: reimbursement for cutting down diseased trees before it's completely dead; \$100/tree up to three trees per property
  - FireWise Grant: \$10K
    - Creating defensible space hire it out, up to \$1,000 in matching funds removing, limbing tree, creating defensible space, thinning brush, etc.
- Other projects in progress
  - Breakaway gates
  - Evacuation signs
  - Need to create evacuation map
  - Garlic mustard weeds
    - Put our trees at more of a threat
    - Asking everyone to pull weeds and then they can spray (it is not glycol\_\_\_\_, which kills weeds) also looking at knapp weed
      - Grants available as well
      - Summit County
- Ask to residents:
  - Please ask fire department to modify their chipping piles to chip everything at one time
  - Take a tour of the neighborhood it's like a plane, you should know where your exits are!

- Park City Leadership is working to increase awareness of defensible space in Summit County
  - Also offering assessments
  - Decided to focus on neighborhoods outside of Summit Park since SP is already

- If you have two trees and you need to remove one, remove the white fir not doing well in our area right now
