Summit Park FireWise Grants

Receive up to \$1,000 to help make your property more FireWise

The Summit Park Home Owners Association (HOA) is offering property owners a monetary incentive to help support our collective neighborhood goal in becoming a fire adaptive community. For approved projects, the HOA will match dollar-for-dollar up to \$1,000 per house or lot to help offset the expense of making your home or lot FireWise. This includes work such as:

- Removing dead or beetle-infested trees
- Removing combustible material, including landscaping mulch and bark chips, pine cones and pine needles around any structures and decks on the property
- Cleaning roof valleys and gutters of pine needles, leaves and debris, which can be a bed for embers

The HOA has partnered with Wasatch Arborists, Royal Tree Services and Canyon Cutters – all local businesses – to provide wildland fire assessment, fuels reduction and tree services. A total of \$8,000 in grant money is available to Summit Park residents. Applications must be received by October 1, 2019.

NEW THIS YEAR: Residents participating in the FireWise *Sites of Excellence* program will have a 2-week lead time to apply for the FireWise grant. Applications for *Sites of Excellence* participants opens immediately, and will be opened up to others starting August 20, 2019.

To Apply:

1. Applicant will receive assessment and bid from Wasatch Arborists, Royal Tree Services or Canyon Cutters (contact information below)
2. Applicant will send a letter of intent via email to the HOA board: summitparkutah@gmail.com. In the email, please include:
 - Name, address, phone number
 - Vendor bid with an explanation of the work you will be completing
3. The HOA will confirm whether you are approved for the grant
4. When the project has been completed, submit your invoice to the HOA via email: summitparkutah@gmail.com. Once this important work is verified, an HOA member will deliver your check

Requirements:

- 2019 HOA dues are paid
- Trees cut down must be removed from the property unless the homeowner intends to use it for firewood
- With permission, before and after pictures may be placed on the HOA website and social properties
- Property owner agrees to have a temporary sign placed on their newly fire adapted lot to promote FireWise awareness
- Recipients acknowledge that the Summit Park Home Owners Association and its current and past board members are not liable for damages resulting from tree removal activities or from Wildland fire
