

Open Fires and Fireworks

Summit Park and surrounding lands are subject to a high fire danger due to the forested nature of the community and surrounding area. Unless otherwise permitted by current local and state laws or directives, all open fires and fireworks are prohibited within Summit Park at all times of the year, regardless of whether they are permitted in areas outside of Summit Park. Exception to this are authorized and/or permitted burning activities, such as the burning of brush and slash piles when outdoor conditions allow



and when all necessary safety precautions are taken to mitigate the potential for fire spreading outside of the controlled area. Fire pits, with at least ten (10) feet of defensible space (defined as a landscaped area void of trees, shrubs, and grass, created around the fire pit), are permissible.
