

Outdoor Lighting / Dark Sky Ordinance

Section 3505.07.D of the Summit County Land Use and Development Code requires that all exterior light fixtures be fully-shielded and down-lit, meaning that the light bulb may not extend below the lowest horizontal plane of the shielding element. These fixtures provide lighting for safety, but seek to limit glare and light pollution to provide minimally inhibited views of the night sky.
